

## **ANPP STAKE HOLDERS TOLD TO ENSURE VICTORY**

As the Local Government elections slated for this month draws nearer, supporters of All Nigeria Peoples Party (ANPP) in Kukawa and Guzamala Local Government in Borno state have been called upon to go from unit to unit for campaign for total victory of the party.

The state Governor Senator Ali Modu Sheriff made the call while addressing members of the party in the hot dry and dusty Baga and Gudumbali towns the Headquarter of Kukawa and Guzamala Local Governments respectively.
